Colorado Medical Cache-Western Slope (CMC-WS)

The CMC-WS purpose is to provide equipment and supplies to Western Colorado medical partners and other emergency incidents.

CMC-WS Objective

- Provide interagency service to local, regional, and statewide medical partners.
 - The CMC-WS is a state cache for all counties in Western Colorado.
 - It provides logistical and material support directly to incidents, organizations supporting incidents, and individual units or projects.



CMC-WS Operations

 The CMC-WS is a state shared resource of disposable and reusable standardized supplies and equipment that are available to meet short-term emergency needs.




State Contract

- The CMC-WS is under contract with OEPR and CDPHE.
- Mesa County is contracted to maintain the storage facility and resource management



Ordering Resources from CMC-WS

- All request for supplies should be submitted using the <u>Emergency Resource Request Form.</u>
- Delivery of supplies will be determined between CMC-WS and the requester.



CMC-WS Inventory

- CDPHE provides PPE such as gloves, face-masks, face-shields, & gowns for emergency use.
- Inventory includes some necessary items for an alternative care site.

Examples Include

- Bedding: Cots, Flannel and Thermal Blankets, and Pillows.
- **Cleaning Supplies:** Alcohol Wipes, Quat Cleaner, Sanitizer, Anti-microbial Soap
- **First Aid/Medical:** AEDs, Bloodborne Pathogen Kit, Folding Stretcher, Syringes, IV Poles, Wheel Chairs, PPE, and PAPRs.
- Other Resources: Air Purifiers, Canopy Tents, AC Units, Generators, Freezers
